Purpose:

to offer a training opportunity for health professionals to learn an approach to preventing, diagnosing, evaluating, treating and managing people with tropical diseases.

Course objectives:

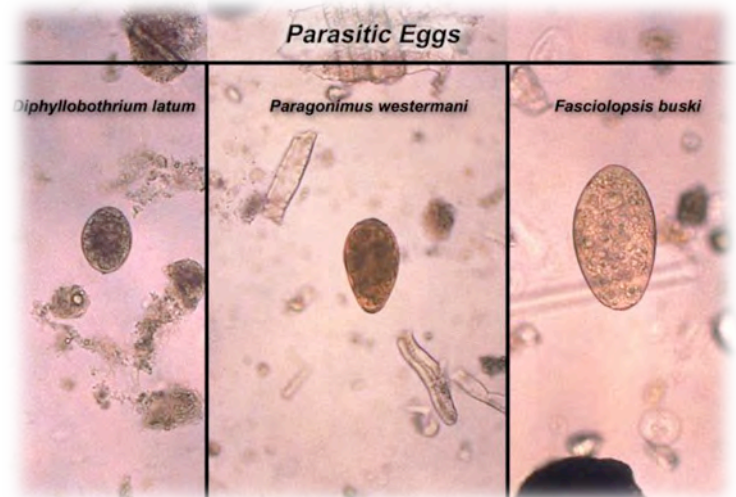
Through didactic lectures, interactive problem-solving discussions and practical laboratory teaching, attendees will learn:

- a clinical approach to the evaluation and management of tropical diseases;
- practical laboratory skills, with a focus on the identification of parasites important for the diagnosis of tropical disease;
- public health principles and applications including outbreak management and environmental health interventions.

The course emphasizes three broad areas:

- (1) Clinical Tropical Medicine
- (2) Parasitology
- (3) Public Health
